Format :

The sessions will be facilitated with the intent of open communication of best practices, resources, and culture towards making our Atlantic Provinces an even stronger network when it comes to coach communication, programming, and education.

Enhancing Club Learn to Skate Programs ([Teaching the Basics](#))

Creation of a viable coaching network to stay connected with regular check-ins between the 2019 retreat and 2021 retreat

Protecting you and the athlete - Coaching Screens, Insurance, Rule of 2, RESPECT in Sport, Concussion Protocol

Coaching and keeping athletes during critical social and physical development years of 11-15 years of age.

Additional Topics for the weekend will be determined by the registered coaches via survey two weeks prior to Retreat.

Who Should attend ?

The primary New Brunswick coach as determined by the club will have lodging and registration covered . These coaches will preferably be the club's head coach or a coach familiar with their clubs programming at all levels . The primary club coach will also be asked to bring a list of all current club coaches to the retreat as this is essential for us to create a coaching network within the province.

It would be preferred that the primary club representative coach stay connected over the course of the next two years up to the 2021 coaching retreat.

We would also like to connect to clubs from outside the province as well to encourage and connect all Atlantic Clubs. Please note that clubs outside the province are responsible for covering costs for their respective club primary representative.

Additional coaches wanting to register should be actively coaching at the club level . We are looking for coaches that are regularly coaching at either Learn to Skate, development, provincial , and above levels. Discussions will be based on creating the best Athlete Pathway possible and this includes Fundamental to Elite Level programming.
