2022-2023 High Performance Coach Report to SSNB AGM

This past season has been a great return to sport at the fullest with New Brunswick athletes competing at local to International Level.

This season we had New Brunswick Athletes competing at:

- Provincial and Atlantic Based Competitions
- Quebec Long Track Cups
- Quebec Provincial and Elite level competitions
- National Youth LT/ST, Junior ST and Senior ST Level Events
- Canada Winter Games Long and Short Track
- ISU Short Track World Cups and World Championships

Some additional highlights from this season were being able to upgrade the following:

- Rejuvenation of the SSNB Board by holding a Special meeting and subsequently having full BOD in place actively working towards future.

- Help create Budget for SSNB BOD and SSNB AD Committee
- Planning and coaching at Canada Winter Games preparation camps
- Away 50 days for camps and competitions
- Actively sat on two key committees with Speed Skate Canada to discuss Athlete Pathway Model as well as competition development
- Work with Athlete Development Committee
- Took care of National Level athlete entries

- Organized time trial event in Fredericton to allow our athletes to achieve times to attend National Level competitions

- Creation and alignment of SSNB Safe Sport Policy, very lengthy process.

- Getting head officials for meet in place and having new Officials chair in place for 2023-2024 season

- Recruiting new recorder in place of our very active NB recorders

- Upgrading of website and many key policies including Athlete Guide, Active Calendar, Terms of reference (AD), etc.

- Ongoing promotion of sport via Speed Skating NB Club based and High-performance based Facebook accounts

- Helped navigate transition of staff role to new funding model within the New Brunswick Funding Model

- Continued ¼ Contract for coaching services as Head Coach with Fredericton Speed Skating Club

- Support towards the clubs in terms of club development and experience in creating programming from Grassroots to Elite

- Support towards committees and Board of Directors. We have had a major shift over the recent few years, and it should be a goal to move forward and back to be a leader nationally as many initiatives over the seasons have had New Brunswick roots.

- Updating of key policies and support material including Provincial team guidelines, committee policies, SSNB Athlete development budget & terms of reference, aligning competition guides to current SSC/FPVQ structure, etc.

- Continued update of website and communications

- Continued and enhanced partnerships with local, provincial, Atlantic, and National sport partnerships

- Actively searching and applying for Grants that would benefit SSNB

- Return to Learn to Train and above level camps + club visits with goal of education and development of both coaches and athletes.

- Active and engaged competitions committee, Athlete Development/Coaching committee, Officials Committee, and Board of Directors working towards common goals

- Overall goal will be to help empower club & volunteers so we can enhance the sport that we already offer. By the second season we will know were gaps still exist and were future PT/FT staff + contracts could be assigned.
